Discover the details of the audiences, gala dinners and treaty signings that have marked the country's history. Wander around the *Plaza de Armas* and admire the exquisite tapestries and classical furniture while you visit the Grand Staircase, the Throne Room and the Gala Dining Room.

After the guided tour, take the opportunity to explore the Royal Armoury at your own pace and discover the impressive collection of armour and weapons used over the centuries. Before ending the experience, enjoy the magnificent views from the Plaza de Armas viewpoint, one of the best spots to admire Madrid from a unique perspective.

The main attraction of the tour is the guided visit to Toledo's Primate Cathedral, one of the most imposing Gothic cathedrals in Spain. Built in the 13th century on the remains of an old Arab mosque, the cathedral reveals a fusion of Christian and Muslim styles. The tour begins with an appreciation of the impressive façade, which leads to an interior full of artistic details. The cathedral's great bell tower stands out on the horizon, visible from various points in the city.

Inside the cathedral, visitors can admire the beauty of the choir, the high altar and the sacristy, which houses several valuable works of art, including some by El Greco. The chapter house also impresses with its unique architecture, a reflection of Toledo's historical splendour.
