We have selected three charming regions of the country to explore in three days: combining a bit of the centre, the north and the south. After leaving Lisbon, we will travel through stunning landscapes, historic cities and traditional corners. An experience not to be missed!

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Leaving Lisbon, head to Sintra to visit the breathtaking Pena Palace, an iconic building at the highest point of the mountain range. Explore the town's historic centre, full of charm and typical sweets such as queijadas and travesseiros. Free time for lunch. The tour continues to Colares, a wine-growing region, and to Cabo da Roca, the westernmost point of continental Europe. Admire the coastal scenery passing Guincho beach and the dramatic Boca do Inferno. End the day in the elegant town of Cascais, returning to Lisbon via the scenic Estoril Coast. **Accommodation in Lisbon.**

On the second day, discover Fátima, one of the most important pilgrimage centres in the world, visiting the Basilica and the Chapel of the Apparitions. After lunch, explore the grandiose Church of the Monastery of Batalha, a World Heritage Site, and head to Nazaré, famous for its fishing traditions and impressive views of the site. Before returning, visit Óbidos, a charming medieval town with preserved walls and picturesque alleys.

Accommodation in Lisbon.

On the last day, set off for Évora, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Cross the Tagus and, amidst landscapes of vineyards and cork oaks, you will see the walls that guard centuries of history. Stroll through the narrow streets and discover the Roman Temple, the Cathedral, the Chapel of Bones and the University. Explore Alentejo's handicrafts and enjoy the region's rich gastronomy, finishing with a wine tasting before returning to Lisbon.

• DAY 1: LISBON | SINTRA | CABO DA ROCA | CASCAIS | ESTORIL | LISBON

From Lisbon, head to the enchanting Pena Palace, high up in the Sintra mountains. After the visit, there will be free time to explore the village of Sintra, with its craft shops, tea houses and the famous local sweet pastry: queijadas and travesseiros.

After lunch overlooking the mountains, you will head to Colares, known for its wines, and enjoy the views of Cabo da Roca, the westernmost point of continental Europe. Pass Guincho beach, Boca do Inferno and finally arrive in Cascais, with its beautiful bay. The journey to Lisbon will take you along the coast, passing through Estoril, admiring the Casino and its gardens.

DAY 2: LISBON | ÓBIDOS | NAZARÉ | BATALHA | FÁTIMA | ALJUSTREL | LISBON

The second day begins with a visit to the town of Óbidos, a charming village surrounded by medieval walls, with white houses and rich handicrafts. Then on to Alcobaça, where the majestic church of the Monastery, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, reveals the tragic love story between D. Pedro and D. Inês de Castro.

Lunch will be in the picturesque fishing village of Nazaré. If possible, you will climb up to the Sítio to admire the breathtaking view of the town and the beaches. Continue to Batalha, where you will explore the Monastery church, a Gothic masterpiece with impressive stained-glass windows.

End the day at the Sanctuary of Fátima, visiting the Chapel of the Apparitions, the Basilica, the Church of the Holy Trinity and the Statue of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Return to Lisbon through a beautiful agricultural region.

DIA 3: LISBON | ÉVORA | LISBON

Explore Évora, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, with a walking tour of its narrow streets and iconic monuments: the Roman temple, the Cathedral, the Chapel of Bones and the University. Discover the local handicrafts and the rich Alentejo gastronomy. After lunch, visit Monte da Ravasqueira.

Return to Lisbon at the end of the day.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION

Uncover the best of central and northern Portugal on an unforgettable 6-day trip. From Óbidos to Braga, passing through Porto and Aveiro, explore cities full of history, stunning landscapes and authentic flavours.

Explore the capital of the North and the Port wine cellars, ending in Minho, between Guimarães and Braga.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Heading north from Lisbon, the first stop will be Óbidos, a medieval town surrounded by walls, where you can discover a traditional liqueur" ginjinha". Continue to Alcobaça, where Pedro and Inês de Castro rest in the monastery church. Continue to Nazaré, a fishing village famous for its legends and long beach, before heading to the Batalha Monastery, one of the most impressive Gothic buildings in Portugal. Arrival in Fátima, where you can attend mass or light a candle in the dedicated space inside the sanctuary.

The next day, travel to Coimbra, where you can explore the famous University of Coimbra and the Church of Santa Clara. Then on to Aveiro, the 'Venice of Portugal', and let yourself be enchanted by the canals and Moliceiros boats, before arriving in Porto, a vibrant city that will be your next discovery.

On the third day, set off to discover Porto, with a visit to the Palácio da Bolsa and its beautiful Arab Hall, the Church of São Francisco, the exponent of the Baroque in Portugal, and explore the famous Port wine cellars.

Afterwards, travel to Minho and discover Guimarães, the birthplace of the nation, and Braga, with its imposing cathedral and Bom Jesus Sanctuary.

We have set aside a day for you to enjoy free time to explore Porto at your own pace and the next day head to Amarante, where you can visit the convent of São Gonçalo and explore the banks of the river Tâmega. Cross the Serra do Marão to Vila Real, where you will visit the gardens of Mateus Palace, before heading to the Douro Valley, famous for its vineyards and Port wine. Pass through Lamego and Viseu, with their historic monuments and lively shopping centres. On the last day, cross Bussaco, where you can enjoy the lush vegetation and the Bussaco Palace, before heading to Tomar to visit the Convent of Christ, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.



Return to Lisbon, completing the trip.

DAY 2: FÁTIMA | COIMBRA | AVEIRO | PORTO

After breakfast, head to Coimbra, with its old university, baroque library and the Church of Santa Clara, where Queen Santa Isabel, famous for the miracle of the roses, rests. In the centre, traditional ceramics and cultural roots stand out. In the afternoon, you will leave for Aveiro, the 'Venice of Portugal', with its canals, Moliceiros boats and famous local pastry Ovos Moles. End of the day in Porto.

DAY 3: PORTO | GUIMARÃES | BRAGA

Breakfast at the accommodation. Explore Porto, with its historic streets, the elegant Palácio da Bolsa and the stunning Arab Room, the rich gilded woodwork of the S. Francisco Church and the lively Ribeira neighbourhood. Visit a traditional Port wine cellar and enjoy a tasting.

Then head towards the Minho region. In Guimarães, the birthplace of the nation, visit the imposing Castle and the Bragança Palace, as well as the medieval historic centre. In Braga, discover Portugal's oldest cathedral and the iconic Bom Jesus Sanctuary, with its beautiful baroque staircase.

DAY 4: PORTO

Breakfast at the hotel. A free day to explore this fascinating city. You can walk through its historic streets, admire impressive monuments, and savour the local cuisine.

• DAY 5: PORTO | AMARANTE | VILA REAL | VALE DO DOURO | LAMEGO | URGEIRIÇA

Breakfast at the hotel. We head to Amarante, a city famous for the Convent of São Gonçalo and its convent sweets. Continue through the Serra do Marão to Vila Real, where you will visit the gardens of the Mateus Palace.

You will then travel through the vineyards of the Douro, the birthplace of Port wine. Stop in Lamego to admire the Sanctuary of Nossa Senhora dos Remédios and taste the traditional Lamego ball.

In Viseu, in the Dão region, visit the Cathedral and the historic streets of the city, celebrating the Lusitanian hero Viriato.

Accommodation in Urgeiriça.

DAY 6: URGEIRIÇA | BUSSACO | TOMAR | LISBON

Breakfast at the hotel. Then towards Bussaco, where the romantic Palace Hotel stands out, a former hunting palace surrounded by unique vegetation.

Continue to Tomar, a city linked to the Order of the Knights Templar, which received these lands in 1159. You will



visit the Convent of Christ, declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. Our tour then finishes in Lisbon.

The next morning, admire the rock formations at Ponta da Piedade before setting off for Sagres, the cradle of Portuguese navigation. At Cabo de São Vicente, marvel at the imposing cliffs that mark the south-western tip of Europe. Back in Lagos, savour the Algarve's gastronomy, rich in fish and seafood.

On the last day, bid farewell to the Algarve with a look at the Atlantic before heading to Setúbal, a port city that overlooks the Troia peninsula. The journey through the Serra da Arrábida reveals lush natural scenery, and the arrival in Lisbon concludes a journey full of history, unforgettable landscapes and authentic flavours.
