## Description

Trekking the Caminito del Rey is an exciting adventure for hiking and nature lovers that takes us back in time. It is a set of walkways of about 3 km, built on the steep slopes of the Gaitanes gorge and 100 meters above the Guadalhorce river. Built between 1901-1905 for the construction of the dam.

Renovated and extended in 2015, they are a fascinating challenge that provide breathtaking views, where some routes are only 1 meter wide.

With transportation from Seville, the route starts in Ardales, crossing the municipality of Antequera and ending in El Chorro. The route is vertiginous as it is sloping over the canyon escarpments providing fascinating views of the Canyon. Once you have finished the Caminito del Rey, transport to a restaurant in the area for a free lunch or to enjoy your picnic.

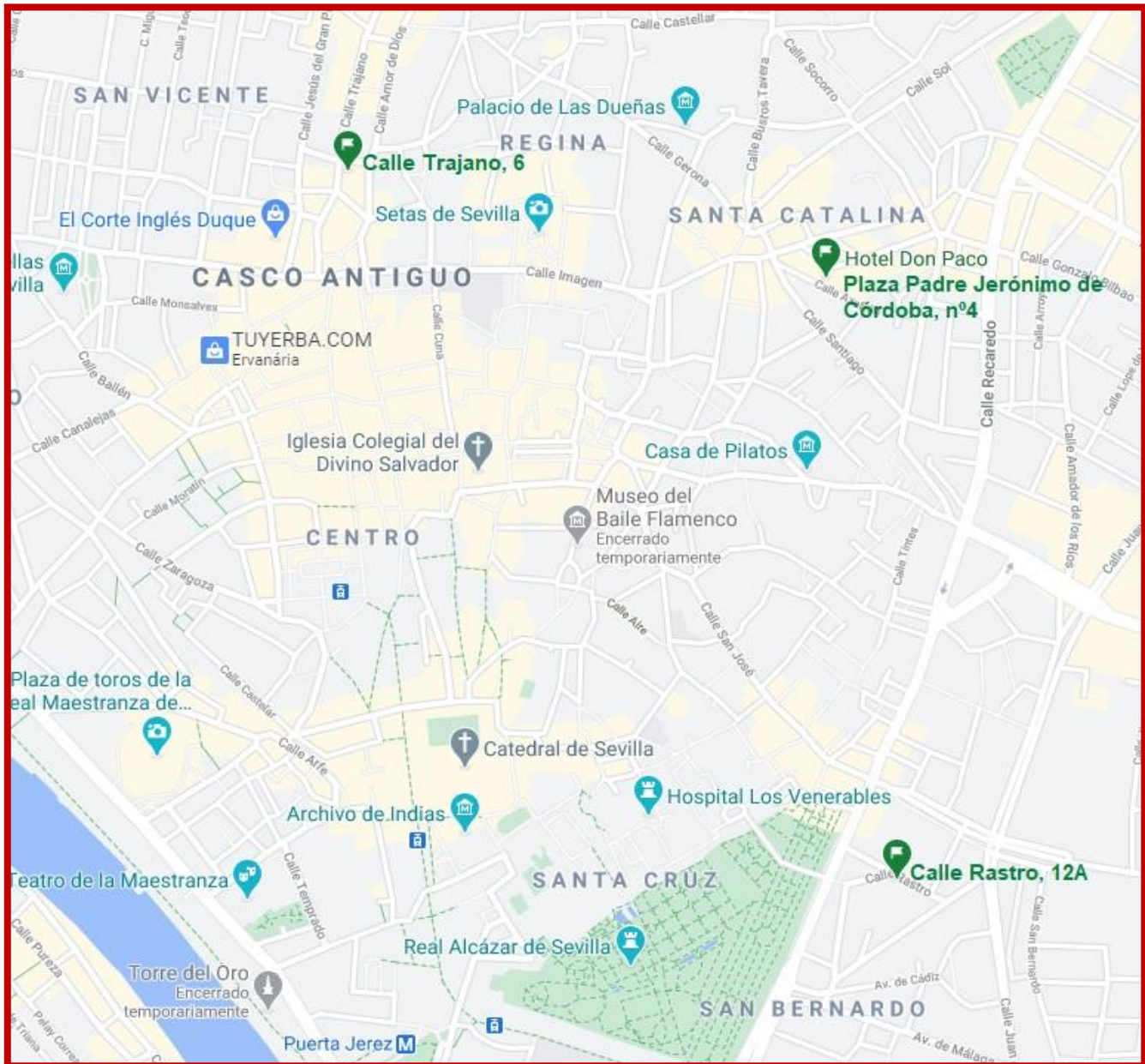

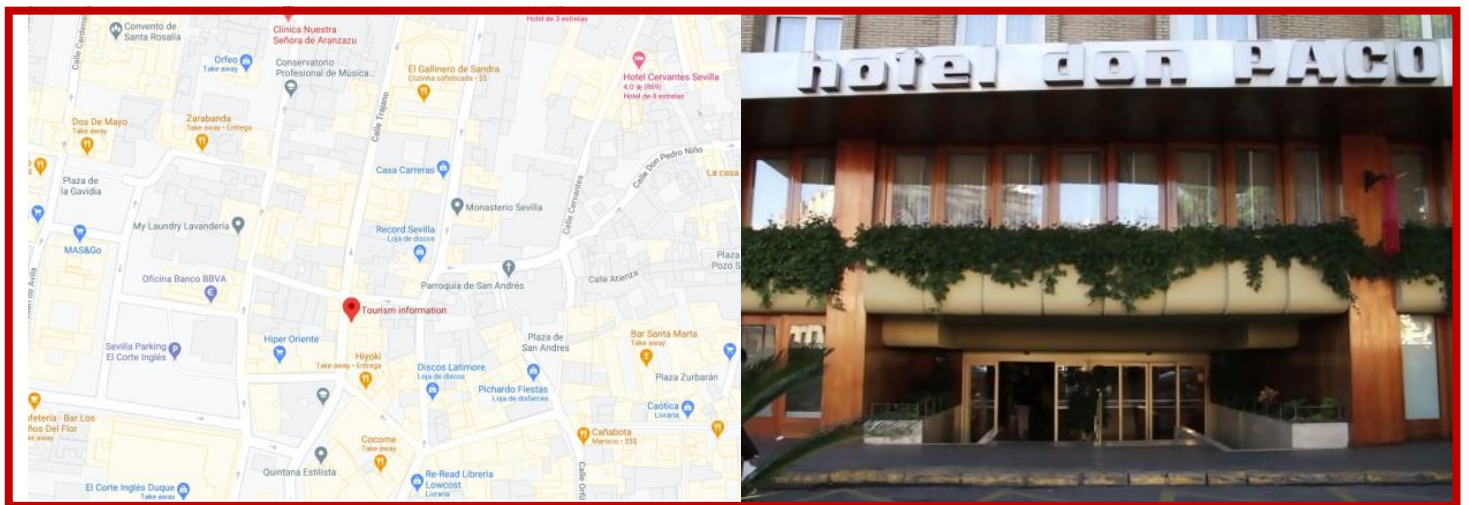




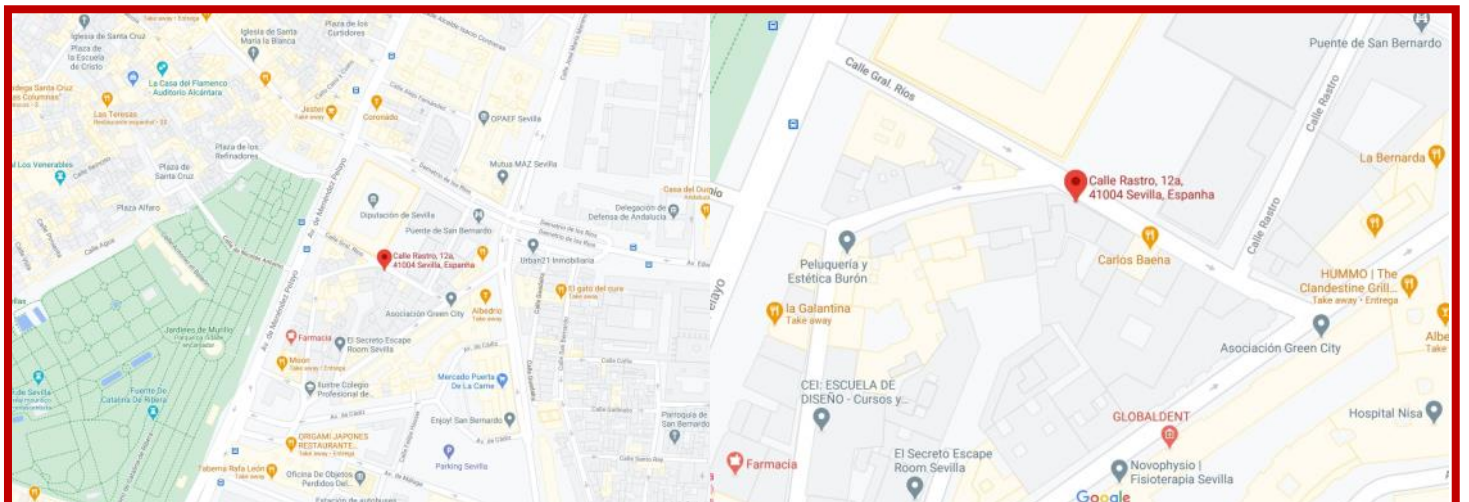
